- a. Discussion about recent OPRA request by Mike Spille; Lambertville has participated in community aggregation for energy
 - \$2100 savings per house
 - \$655K aggregate savings
 - 100% renewable component (green component)

II. DEIS Comment Discussion

- a. Keep it local, specific concerns
 - i. Heavy haul roads map
 1. Rt 29 is truck ban which allows you to get to and for deliveries and pickups; their design of the route forces a violation of the truck ban
 2. We only have two ways to get into Lambertville, every route will completely isolate Lambertville from the north end of the entryway leaving only entry out of Pennsylvania
 - a. Threat to business
 - ii. Swan Creek, Alexauken Creek, Delaware River issues
 1. Alexauken is C1 class
 2. Concerns from the citizens - arsenic
 - iii. Historic road: Stymiest Access Road
 1. Last untouched path in the Revolutionary War in the US
 2. Visitors come based on historical elements near our city; one of the main reasons people come here
