

**LAMBERTVILLE COMMUNITY ADVISORY TEAM**  
**MEETING HIGHLIGHTS**  
**JUNE 17, 2020**

The first meeting of the Lambertville Community Advisory Team (“CAT”) was held on June 17, 2020. The following items were discussed at the organizational meeting of the CAT:

1. Each member provided a summary of their background including where they have worked, their community involvement and the reason(s) why they wanted to be a member of the CAT.
2. The CAT mission statement was read.
3. It was determined that the regular monthly meetings will be held on the first Thursday of the month from 6:00 – 8:00 PM. The meetings will be held virtually.
4. There was a discussion about the date and time for a second monthly meeting, but no decision was made. The fourth Monday of the month was recommended. A final decision will be made at the CAT meeting on July 2, 2020.
5. Because of the timeframe set forth in the recent ruling from Judge Miller and the City’s commitment to focus on community engagement around community development in 2020, the CAT’s primary focus during 2020 will be the City’s Affordable Housing Obligations.
6. The overview of the City’s facility evaluation process will be the next major focus of the CAT.
7. At the present time CAT is considering 3 subcommittees:
  - Public Engagement
  - Design/Zoning
  - Environment
8. Discussions about these subcommittees included methods to effectively engage all members of the public during the period of virtual meetings, how to provide an understanding of the financial issues relating to these topics in a method which is understandable to the community, possible experts who can provide information to the CAT about various issues relating to the Police Station site (i.e. environmental issues, etc.).
9. A request was made for a volunteer(s) to be the Secretary of the CAT.

The next regular meeting will be held virtually on Thursday, July 2, 2020. We will also announce public meeting dates in the near future and those dates will be noticed.
