The meeting of the Trustees of the Lambertville Free Public Library was called to order at 7:06 PM by Matt Larkin. Community Relations: Another community survey that targets the Spanish community started at Fisherman's Mark on April 15. From the 8 surveys so far, there is interest in more Spanish materials at the library and a Spanish portal on the library website. In addition, many were not aware of services the library provided. Planning on running the survey at least 2 weeks. There has been a small fundraising event to fund museum passes. Fisherman's Mark also shared some information on donor management software.

Finance & Facilities: Mayor is offering to give Library \$50,000 capital. The Lilly St porch is a hazard. Want to stabilize and repair porch. Other ideas were explored as well, such as 3 upstairs windows needing to be replaced. North porch steps are ok but stringers, deck, railing, etc need to be replaced. Was to meet with CAT but they needed to reschedule.
