

**Lambertville Community Advisory Team
Meeting Highlights
January 25, 2021**

Update since the last meeting:

- The co-chairs introduced and welcomed Jeanna Korzun to the CAT.
- The co-chairs noted they had met with newly sworn-in City Council members, Benedetta Lambert and Steve Stegman, to bring them up-to-date on CAT activities and begin building a collaborative relationship regarding the CAT's future work .

Communications/Public Outreach update:

- With input from Mayor Fahl and Council President Taylor, the communications subcommittee has largely completed writing the survey on the subject of the Closson site. The current draft will be distributed to the full CAT and the City Council for a final review before being distributed to the public in early February.
- The survey will be available in both English and Spanish.
- The survey will be available to residents and non-resident business owners.
- The survey will be distributed in both electronic and paper forms via a variety of methods: Lambertville Matters, Fisherman's Mark, senior living facilities, SHRSD listserv (pending agreement), CAT stakeholder lists, and possibly other community-based listservs.
- The public will have about two weeks to respond. The survey will take about ten minutes to complete.
- The CAT will host a Q&A with the Closson family to better understand the history of the property , as well as provide general information about the market, farm buildings, etc.
- The CAT co-chairs will host a Q&A with the mayor to review the CAT's evolving responsibilities.
- The CAT will likely host another Q&A with the mayor about the due diligence process and timeline of the proposed purchase of the Closson site.

Talk of the Town:

One member noted that, in conversations with two neighbors, enthusiastic support for the purchase of the Closson farm was expressed.

Preparations for Facility Discussion:

Working with the mayor and City Council, the co-chairs have begun to prepare for a broader facilities review.
