SUEZ ANNOUNCES 2021 WATER MAIN AND FIRE HYDRANT MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE FOR LAMBERTVILLE

Beginning the week of October 11, 2021, SUEZ will be performing annual water main and fire hydrant maintenance in Lambertville. The maintenance, which is critical to sustain high quality drinking water and ensure reliable use for fire protection, is expected to continue through approximately Friday, October 22, 2021, weather permitting.

"It is important to remove sediment build-up in fire hydrants from to ensure that water can quickly flow through the pipes when needed," said Jim Mastrokalos, Director of Operations. "This cleaning also serves a critical role in ensuring that SUEZ customers receive top quality water service within their homes and businesses," he added.

Crews are scheduled to work Monday through Friday between the hours of 9 AM to 3:30 PM in the Lambert's Hill Development, Woodcrest Development and the Calton Development. There will be no hydrant maintenance on Monday, October 11, 2021 in observance of the Columbus Day holiday.

Beginning on or about the week of October 18, 2021, SUEZ crews are scheduled to work at night from 9 PM to 6 AM within downtown Lambertville. Crews will begin on the south side and proceed to the north side of Lambertville.

While maintenance is being performed, customers may temporarily experience low pressure or volume and slight discoloration or cloudiness of tap water. If discoloration or cloudiness occurs, SUEZ recommends that customers shut the water off for 5 to 10 minutes. They can then check clarity by running a cold water tap for a few minutes. This process allows time for new water to work its way through the pipes.

SUEZ advises both residential and business customers to avoid using tap water, washing machines and dishwashers, if they observe SUEZ crews working in their area. Customers may wish to fill up clean bottles or containers with tap water ahead of time and store them in the refrigerator to use for drinking or cooking while the program is conducted in their area. Customers are also asked to be attentive while walking or driving near SUEZ trucks and crew members to ensure safety.
